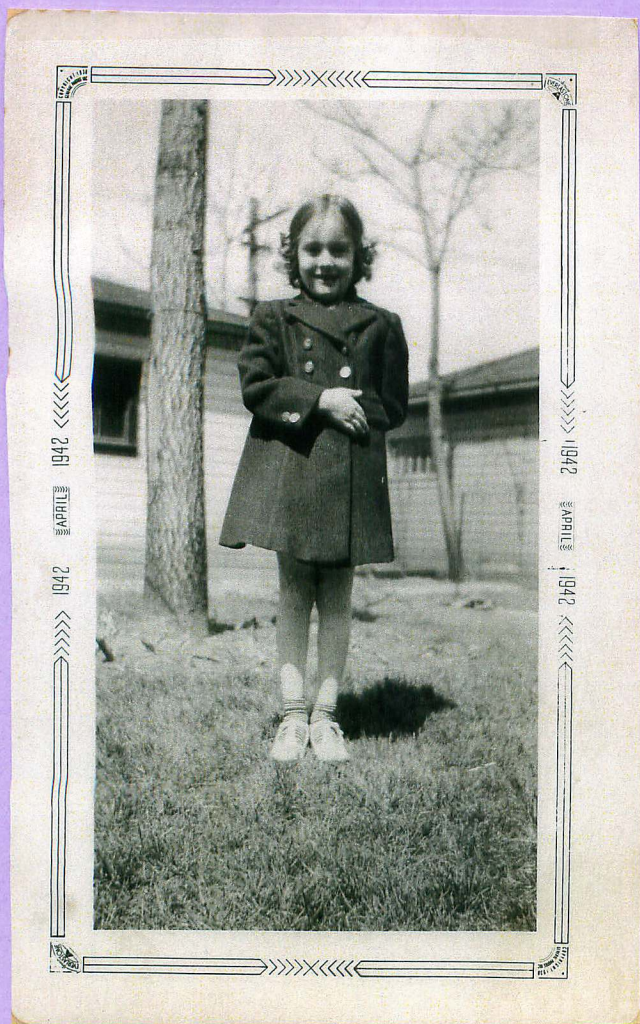

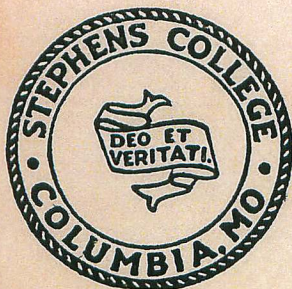

The youthful aviatrix piloted a single engine Piper cub sea plane.

Nancy, who has had seven

hours and forty minutes of instruction in the air, said she hopes to get her private pilot's license by next Summer.

When asked how she became interested in flying, Nancy said:

"I flew in a plane for the first time when I was three years old and I have been enthusiastic about airplanes ever since."

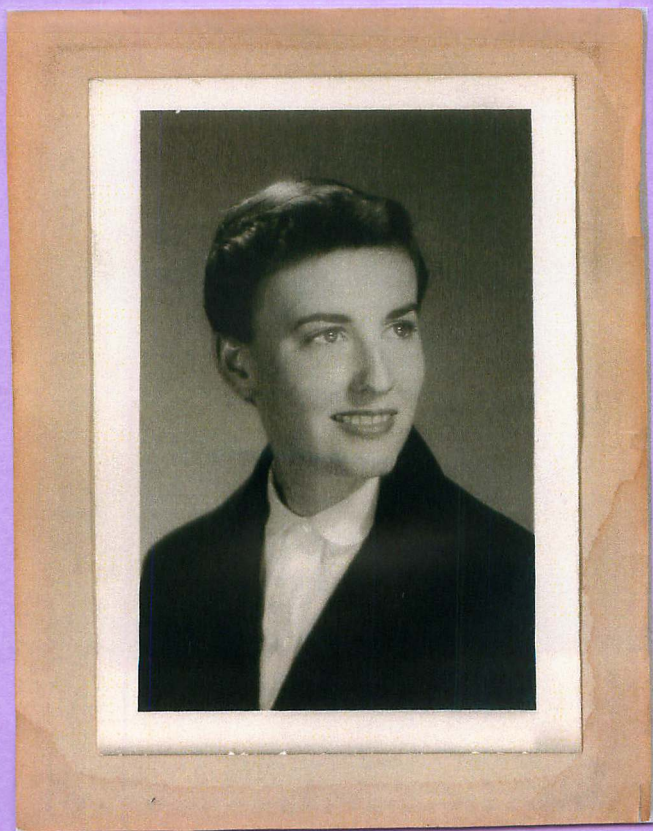

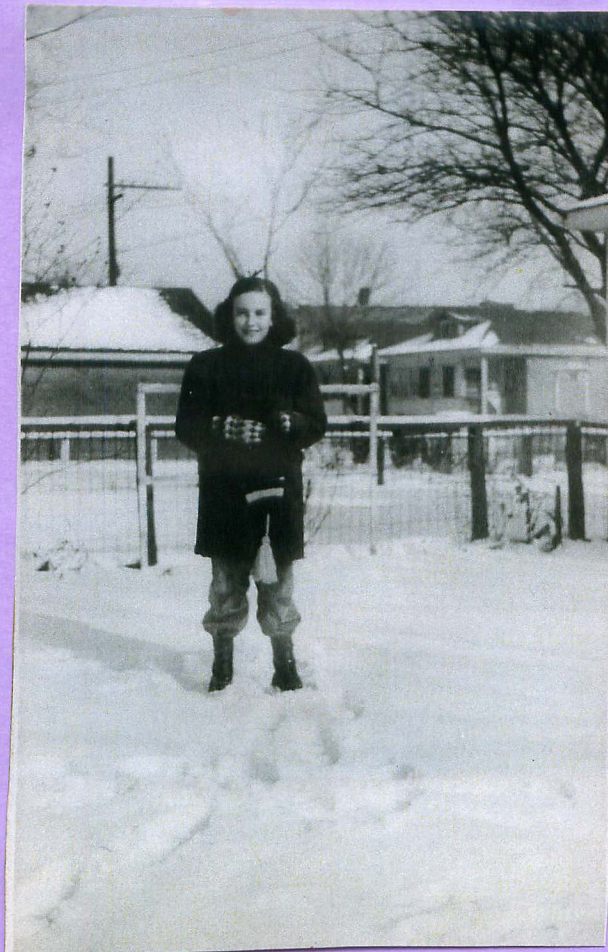

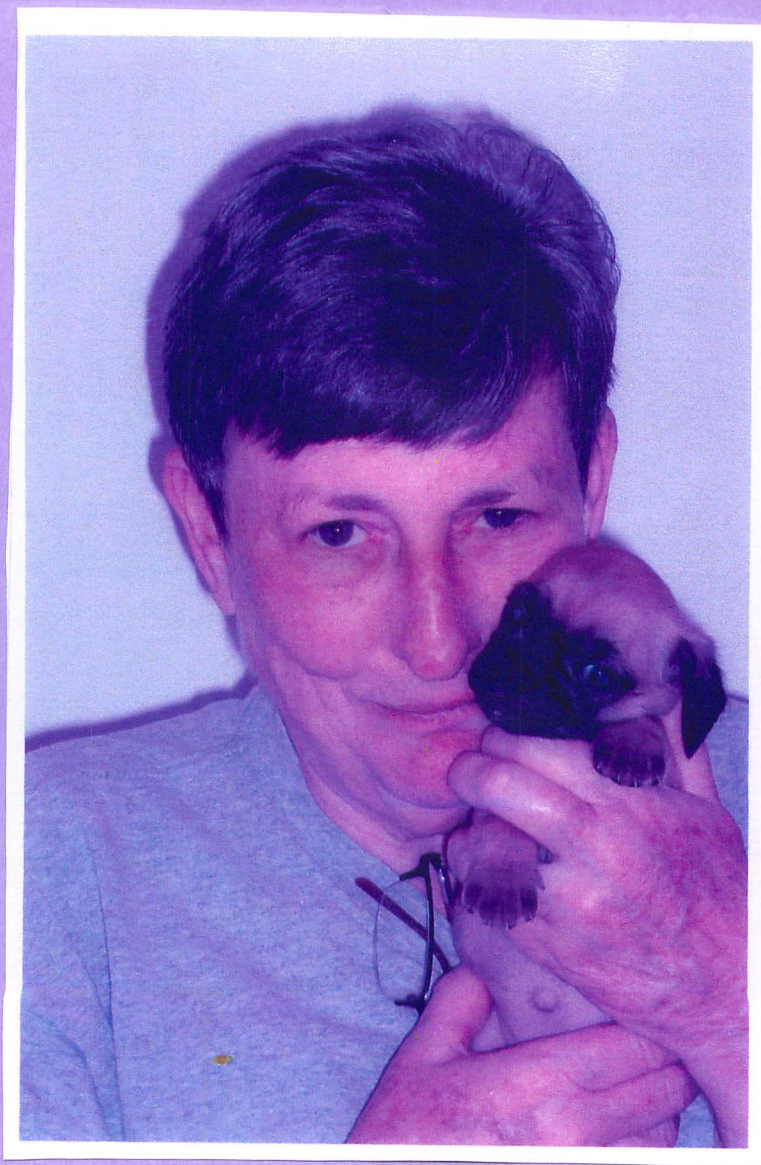
